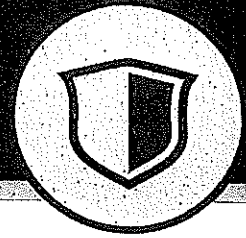


Self-Screening To Replace In-person Screening Stations for Employees



Beginning Monday, Sept. 21, we are moving away from screening stations and temperature checks for employees and will begin self-screening. You no longer need to come through this line.

Why are we doing this?

The low number of employees flagged during the in-person screenings tells us that you are doing a great job at staying home-essentially self-screening already-if you are sick.

What's changing?

- All employees, whether working from home or working on-site, will need to self-screen.
- Temperature checks will no longer be required. We've learned that taking temperatures during screening isn't effective, although having a fever is still a COVID-19 symptom.

Exempt (salaried) blue badge employees as well as contracted green badge staff self-screen each day using a link to a website survey – covidscreen.cchmc.org (or using the QR code below). Once there, bookmark the link for future use. All employees using the website need to have multi-factor authentication set up. Call the Help Desk at 636-4100 if needed.

Nonexempt (hourly) blue badge employees will complete your symptom check when you clock in whether onsite or at home. When you swipe, a symptom list will appear on screen. You will need to click that you do not have symptoms before you move to your clock-in screen. You will not be able to clock in until you answer the question.

Masks

There will be an employee lane with hand sanitizer and new masks at locations where there is still an in-person screening station (Liberty, College Hill and Burnet campuses-including MOB and Winslow). Additional locations are being developed and will be communicated once known.
