

CAREER EXPLORATION MICRO-GRANT GUIDELINES

The Regional Career Exploration Collaborative (RCEC) is tasked with building and operating quality healthcare career exploration programs for middle and high school students in the Greater Cincinnati region. **The goal of our 2026 Micro-Grant process is to create or expand meaningful healthcare career exploration opportunities for middle and high school students.**

Application Opens: January 7, 2026 / Applications Due: February 20, 2026

TO APPLY: bit.ly/RCEC

Eligibility:

- Be a registered nonprofit organization, educational institution, or government entity.
- Demonstrate ability to deliver successful middle or high school student programming.
- Have the capacity to manage and implement the proposed program.
- Commit to reporting and evaluation requirements.

Information:

- Grants up to \$3,000, per proposal.
- Grants should be a minimum of \$500, per proposal
- Programs should be completed by November 15, 2026, with data & results reported by December 1, 2026.
- Grants are encouraged to be used for (But not limited to):
 - **Content and Program Development;**
 - **Program Supplies** - includes items like books, workbooks, Stop the Bleed Kits, CPR Certification, mannequins;
 - **Student Supports** - includes covering tuition and fees, transportation, personal student equipment such as stethoscopes, white coats, program tee shirts, and food/snacks

Selection Process:

- All Proposals will be reviewed by a selection committee.
- Selection will be based on alignment with the grant's goal, program feasibility, organizational capacity, and budget justification.
- Applicants will be notified on or before March 6, 2026.
