THE VITAL ROLE OF A NURSE

A nurse is a primary member of your care team. In addition to providing hands-on care and monitoring, your nurse coordinates your care plan and communicates with you, your family and your care team about your condition. Their clinical knowledge and critical thinking prepare them to:

- Observe, assess, and record a patient's condition
- Administer patients' medications and treatments
- Set up plans for a patient's care or contribute information to existing plans
- Consult and collaborate with other healthcare professionals
